

### **Dr. Leif Hanitsch**

Dr. Leif Hanitsch studied Medicine in Berlin (Germany) and Immunology in Oxford (UK). For his medical dissertation he stayed at the Rockefeller University (USA) in Michel Nussenzweig's lab of Molecular Immunology. Leif Hanitsch holds board certification for Internal Medicine and Pulmology. He is Senior consultant at the Institute for Medical Immunology, Charité, Berlin (Germany) and takes care of adult patients with primary and secondary immunodeficiency as well as autoinflammatory disorders. Leif Hanitsch is leading coordinator for the German National Guideline on treatment of primary antibody deficiency and participates in the National Guideline on Bronchiectasis.
