



### **Ethicist Prof James Taylor**

James Stacey Taylor is a Professor of Philosophy at The College of New Jersey. He has written over 100 academic articles and book reviews. He is the author of five books, including *Stakes and Kidneys*, *Practical Autonomy and Bioethics*, *Death, Posthumous Harm, and Bioethics*, and *Markets with Limits*. His most recent book (March 2022) is *Bloody Bioethics: Why prohibiting donor compensation harms patients and wrongs donors*.

In addition to his academic writing he has authored numerous Op-Eds on bioethical issues which have appeared in publications such as the *Los Angeles Times*, the *New York Daily News*, and *USA Today*. His award-winning Op-Ed for the *Los Angeles Times* was credited with influencing the ruling of the 6<sup>th</sup> District Court circuit that led to the legalization of payment for bone marrow. He is an occasional contributor to National Public Radio and has been quoted in *The New York Times*.
