



Prof Stephan Ehl

Stephan Ehl graduated in medicine from the University of Munich in 1992. Following his internship, he worked as a Post-Doc at the Institute for Experimental Immunology (Prof. Zinkernagel) in Zürich. Since 1998, Stephan Ehl works as a paediatrician at the University Medical Center in Freiburg. Since 2008, he serves as Medical Director of the Centre of Chronic Immunodeficiency (CCI). His research group “Human T-cell immunodeficiency“ explores human T cell immunity through analysis of three immunodeficiency states: profound combined immunodeficiencies, HLH and autoimmune-lymphoproliferative immunodeficiencies. The research projects encompass the whole spectrum of translational research from the identification and characterization of novel gene defects followed by pathophysiological studies in mouse models and human patients to the development of novel diagnostic tools and using this knowledge in the design of international registry and treatment studies.
