



Prof. Fabio Candotti

Fabio Candotti is Associate Professor of Medicine at the University of Lausanne and Head Physician in the Division of Immunology and Allergy of the Lausanne University Hospital, in Lausanne, Switzerland.

After studying Medicine at the University of Brescia (Italy), Pediatrics at the University of Pavia (Italy), and Pediatric Allergy and Immunology at the University of Brescia (Italy), he joined the National Institutes of Health in the USA where he performed postdoctoral research in the field of gene therapy.

Dr. Candotti's clinical and research interests are the discovery of the genetic and molecular bases of primary immunodeficiencies and the development of gene therapy approaches for these diseases. He has published more than 170 indexed publications and 60 reviews and book chapters on primary immunodeficiency diseases and gene therapy.

He currently serves as President-Elect of the European Society for Immunodeficiency, Associate Editor of Pediatric Allergy and Immunology, and Specialty Chief Editor of the Primary Immunodeficiencies section of Frontiers.
